September's Memory Verses:

Monday- Read Augusts' daily Proverb for today- Proverbs 30

Read Ephesians 5:33

Truth: It is possible to love someone without respecting that person.

Prayer: Father, help me to love and respect my husband.

Question: What do I need to do to make sure my loved ones feel respected?

Action: Verbally encourage your spouse concerning the many tasks they perform each day.

Tuesday- Read Augusts' daily Proverb for today- Proverb 31

Read Proverbs 31:10

Truth: A good marriage is priceless.

Prayer: Father, help me to meet the needs of my spouse each and every day.

Thought: Do I have any unspoken needs that are not being met by my spouse? Have I asked my spouse lately, "How am I doing fulfilling all of your needs?"

Action: Communicate with your spouse about any unmet needs either of you might have.

Wednesday- Read Romans 1

Read Ephesians 5:22-24

Truth: God has designed men to be in the position of authority.

Prayer: Lord, teach me to support those you have put into authority.

Thought: Perfect submission to a perfect God is the example for us to follow in submitting to others. Eph 5:21

Action: Support the hope and desire of another with both words of encouragement and action.

Thursday- Read Romans 2

Read Proverbs 31:30-31

Truth: A women who fears the Lord is to be praised.

Prayer: Father what godly woman should I encourage today.

Listen: As you pray listen to the leading of the Holy Spirit.

Action: Send a note of encouragement today as the Holy Spirit directs.

Friday- Read Romans 3

Choose a verse from Proverbs 31 that touches your heart

Prayer: Pray that God gives you wisdom and insight into that verse.

Truth: Write out the truth God is revealing to you from that verse?

Decision: Commit to living out this truth.

Question: Write out a question that arises from Proverbs 31

Action: Seek the answer to your question through prayer and other verses in the bible.
