Matthew 28:16-20

So **Jesus** says, *I am with you always...*

Monday 6/6- Read Matthew 28:16-20

Blessing: *And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.*"

Truth: *Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.*

Meditate: Matthew 28:19 – *Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.*

Prayer: Lord, thank you for always being here with me. Help me to tell others about how wonderful you are.

Action: Ask someone from outside of our church to join you in an Action Group activity.

What is God asking ME to do: _____

Tuesday 6/7- Read Psalm 73:1-28

Question: *They say, "How would God know? Does the Most High know anything?"* Vs. 11

Truth: *When I tried to understand all this, it troubled me deeply till I entered the sanctuary of God; then I understood their final destiny.* Vs. 16-17

Meditate: Psalm 73:28– *But as for me, it is good to be near God. I have made the Sovereign Lord my refuge; I will tell of all your deeds.*

Prayer: *Yet I am always with you; you hold me by my right hand. You guide me with your counsel and afterward you will take me into glory.* Vs. 23-24

Action: *I will tell of all your deeds.* Vs. 28

What God is telling me:

Wednesday 6/8- Read Luke 15:1-7

Question: Why should I venture out to find those people who are "lost"?

Truth: Jesus said; *"there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent."* Vs. 7

Meditate: Matthew 28:19-20- *Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."*

Prayer: Lord, you came to seek and save the lost. Thank you for loving me and saving me.

Action: Follow the example of Christ by loving others.

Who is God asking me to reach out to in love:

Thursday 6/9- Read Luke 15:8-10

Question: "Or suppose a woman has ten silver coins and loses one. Doesn't she light a lamp, sweep the house and search carefully until she finds it?"

Truth: *I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.*

Meditate: Luke 19:10 - *For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."*

Prayer: Lord, thank you for your love and grace. Help me to be loving and have grace towards others.

Action: *For I am not seeking my own good but the good of many, so that they may be saved.* 1 Cor. 10:33

What God is telling me:

Friday 6/10- Read Luke 15:11-32

Question: What did the father do when he saw his *lost son* return?

Truth: *"But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion for him; he ran to his son, threw his arms around him and kissed him.* Vs. 20

Meditate: Luke 15:24- *For this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.' So they began to celebrate.*

Prayer: Father your love and forgiveness is amazing.

Action: *Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.* Colossians 3:13
