



God’s Word on Always: Love always does the right thing!

Truths that stand the Test of Time...

Last week: Always *worship* the Lord in everything we do.
1 Peter 3:15-16

Today’s Big Point:

⇒ Love always does the right thing.

I Corinthians 13:4 NKJV: Love suffers long ...

In every relationship Love will suffer - But – let us remember there is a DIFFERENCE for the Christian!

Love suffers long and is kind ✓

Ex: When your kids are being disobedient: You **can** do what Eph. 4:15 says: *speak the truth in love*, **IF** you *allow* the Holy Spirit to HELP YOU ...

James 1:19-21

How to Tame Your Anger

get rid of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent and humbly accept the word planted in you, which can save you. James 1:21

#1) Take away what fuels your anger.

#2) Humbly accept the word in your head, your heart and your hands. **Psalm 119:9-11**

You can use this process to train yourself in righteousness.

With that formula in mind, let’s look again at the Love chapter.

1 Corinthians 13:4-8 NKJV 4 Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up 5 does not behave rudely does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil 6 does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; 7 bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. 8 Love never fails. - That is good stuff right there right?! If you applied that process with this section of scripture – how would you love?

Love always... 1 Corinthians 13:1-13

June's Memory Verse – *Rejoice always, 1Thessalonians 5:16*

Monday 6/27- Read 1 Corinthians 13:1-3

Question: If I do great things – (even great spiritual things) - without love what do I gain?

Truth: Without love I **AM** Nothing and I **GAIN** Nothing.

Meditate: 1 Corinthians 13:2 – *If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing.*

Prayer: Father God, teach me to love, so I can truly love others.

Action: *Do everything in love.* 1 Corinthians 16:14

Parts of my life where love is lacking:

Tuesday 6/28- Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-7

Question: Understanding that God's love is more than a feeling, What will love do?

Truth: *Love always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.* Vs. 7

Meditate: 1 Corinthians 13:66 – *Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth.*

Prayer: Father God, thank you for giving your love to me. I know I can trust in you and what your love will do through me.

Action: Be kind and patient with others.

What God is telling me:

Wednesday 6/29- Read 1 Corinthians 13:8-13

Question: Will God ever stop loving me?

Truth: *Love never fails.*

Meditate: 1 Corinthians 13:12- *Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known.*

Prayer: Lord Jesus, thank you for your love and the eternal difference it is making in me.

Action: *And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.* Vs. 13

What God is telling me:

Thursday 6/30- Read 1 John 4:7-21

Question: Where does 'agape' love come from?

Truth: *Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God.* Vs. 7

Meditate: 1 John 4:17- *This is how love is made complete among us so that we will have confidence on the day of judgment: **In this world we are like Jesus.***

Prayer: Lord God, You are love. Help me be like Jesus and love others with your love.

Action: *And he has given us this command: Anyone who loves God must also love their brother and sister.*

People to love with God's love:

Friday 7/1- Read John 13:34-35

Question: At the Last Supper what "new command" did Jesus give to his disciples?

Truth: *"A new command I give you: Love one another. **As I have loved you, so you must love one another.***

Meditate: James 2:8- *If you really keep the royal law found in Scripture, "Love your neighbor as yourself," you are doing right.*

Prayer: Lord, continue to help me Learn to Love God and Love Others.

Action: *By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."*
