



Jesus Changed Everything – Who is this Jesus?

The Triumphant Entry.

Jesus needed to be [in Jerusalem](#) for the week of Passover.

John 1:29 – John the Baptist declares the purpose of Jesus Messiah - It was **strategically important** for Jesus *to be in the right place at the right time* – Jerusalem and the Temple - for this Passover.

Passover is one of [Three Pilgrimage Festivals](#) of the Jewish Nation.

- **Pesach** - [Unleavened Bread/ Passover](#) –

⇒ Come this Good Friday and experience *a Taste* of Passover!

- **Shavuot** - [Pentecost](#) – or the Festival of [Weeks](#) –
- **Sukkot** - the Festival of [Shelters](#).

Matthew 21:10 “Who is this?” they asked.

Matthew 21:9-10 That praise is from Psalm 118:26 In the Greek *Praise God* is **Hosanna** = [Save now](#).

Luke 19:41-44 Jesus weeps over the city.

One of the many miracles Jesus did was *prophecy*. There are two kinds of prophecies:

One is *predicting* the future, or [foretelling](#).

Another type of prophecy is *Speaking on behalf of God*, or [forthtelling](#).

Monday 4/10- Read Matthew 21:1-11

Question: *When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred and asked, "Who is this?"* Vs. 10

Truth: The most important question of all; Who is this, Jesus?

Meditate: *"Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!"*

Prayer: Jesus, you are my Lord and Savior.

Action: Worship the Lord with gladness.

Tuesday 4/11- Read Mark 11:1-11

Question: If anyone asks you, 'Why are you doing this?' say, 'The Lord needs it and will send it back here shortly.'" Vs. 3

Truth: When the Lord wants to use my belongings it is always best to say, YES, Lord.

Meditate: *"Blessed is he (Insert my name) who comes in the name of the Lord!"*

Prayer: Lord, I will give you whatever you ask whether it is of myself or my belongings.

Action: Glorify God with my life and my possessions.

What will I do to glorify God today: _____

Wednesday 4/12- Read Luke 19:28:44

Question: Why were Jesus' disciples praising him joyfully as he entered Jerusalem?

Truth: *When he came near the place where the road goes down the Mount of Olives, the whole crowd of disciples began joyfully to praise God in loud voices for all the miracles they had seen:* Vs. 37

Meditate: Luke 19:40- "I tell you," he replied, "if they keep quiet, the stones will cry out."

Prayer: *Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever.* Psalm 118:1

Action: *Shout for joy to the LORD, all the earth.*

Worship the LORD with gladness;

come before him with joyful songs.

Know that the LORD is God.

It is he who made us, and we are his;

we are his people, the sheep of his pasture. Psalm 100:1-3

What God is telling me _____

Thursday 4/13- Read John 12:12-19

Questions: Why is it at times I can't see God working in my life but only much later looking back do I see how God has been working in my life all along?

Truth: *At first his disciples did not understand all this. Only after Jesus was glorified did they realize that these things had been written about him and that these things had been done to him.* Vs.16

Meditate: John 12:14-15 *Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it, as it is written: "Do not be afraid, Daughter Zion; see, your king is coming, seated on a donkey's colt."*

Prayer: Father God, you know all things and how best to work them out for your glory and my benefit. Thank you for always working on my behalf.

Action: *Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding.* Proverbs 3:5

What God is telling me _____

Friday 4/14- Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-7

Challenge: *By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain.*

Truth: *For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures,*

Meditate: Romans 1:16- *For I am not ashamed of the **gospel**, because it is the **power** of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile.*

Prayer: Ask God to open a door to your neighbors to share the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Action: Invite my neighbors to meet Jesus this Sunday at church.

Jesus borrowed a donkey's colt from a stranger because He "needed it". What of yours has Jesus asked to use and what happened when you let him have it?

Read John 12:12-19

Jesus experienced opposition even during his triumphal entry. What kinds of opposition have you experienced for being a follower of Jesus Christ?
