How God Powers the life of a Christian. **Acts 1:3-8**

- 1) Jesus says you will [BE my witnesses](#).
- 2) You are going to have [an impact](#) on your world.

The Holy Spirit IS [the power source](#) to make this happen.

Power in v8 = *Dunamis* –

✓ The book of Acts is filled with examples of believers filled with Spirit – and [many different ways](#) that the Holy Spirit manifested Himself in supernatural ways.

The Holy Spirit can do [anything he needs to do](#) in you so you can complete your mission for God.

He can give you the *right words* to say to someone.

He can help you have the *right attitude*.

He can help you do *whatever* he calls you to do.

The Holy Spirit’s power – it’s purpose is to equip YOU and I to **BE** a Witness for Jesus ⇨ **Revelation 19:9-10**

We must BE [an authentic](#) witness. Be real. Ephesians 5:15-20

Being filled with the Spirit is [an ongoing process](#).

Monday 5/1- Read Acts 2:36-41

Question: *When the people heard this, they were cut to the heart and said to Peter and the other apostles, “Brothers, what shall we do?”*

Truth: *Peter replied, “Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.*

Meditate: Acts 2:39 *The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off—for all whom the Lord our God will call.”*

Prayer: Lord thank you for not only the forgiveness of my sins but also the power of the Holy Spirit to bless my life.

Action: Live by the Spirit.

What is God asking ME to do: _____

Tuesday 5/2- Read Galatians 5:13-26

Question: How should we live having received the gift of the Holy Spirit?

Truth: *Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.* Vs. 25

Meditate: Galatians 5:18- *But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.*

Prayer: Lord, lead me so that I may stay in step with the Holy Spirit.

Action: *For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: “Love your neighbor as yourself.”*

Who will I love as myself today: _____

Wednesday 5/3- Read Ephesians 1:15-23

Truth: *I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, and his incomparably great power for us who believe. **That power is the same as the mighty strength he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms,** Vs.18- 20*

Meditate: Ephesians 1:22-23- *And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church, which is his body, the fullness of him who fills everything in every way.*

Prayer: Lord, you are the head and I am part of the body your church, tell me what you want me to do.

Action: Do as the Lord directs.

Thursday 5/4- Read Acts 1:1-11

Question: *Then they gathered around him and asked him, “Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?”* Vs. 6

Truth: *He said to them: “It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority.* Vs. 7

Meditate: Acts 1:8- *But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”*

Prayer: Father God, your timing is always perfect. Use me for your glory today.

Action: BE Jesus' witness every day in every way.

What God is telling me _____

Friday 5/5- Read Galatians 5:13-26

Challenge: *So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.* Vs. 16

Truth: *For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want.* Vs.17

Meditate: Galatians 5:18- *But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.*

Prayer: *Teach me to do your will, for you are my God; may your good Spirit lead me on level ground.* Psalm 143:10

Action: *Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.*
