✓ Ask God for a personal verse of promise for you this year.

✓ **When you follow Jesus, you find true Life.**

- Did you have a key word or verse God gave you in 2020? How did it help you?
- Read Romans 12:2. Are you conforming to the world to God’s way of thinking? How do you know?
- Pastor said in the sermon: “... the way we *think*, affects the way we *feel*, and the way we *feel* affects the **choices** we *make* and the **way we live**.” What are your thoughts on the matter?
- Read Romans 8:5-6. What is dominating or controlling your thoughts?
- Read 2 Corinthians 10:3-5. How are you doing fighting the fight of faith? Anything in this passage might help you win your battles?
- Join the 21 day Daniel fast. May the Lord lead you and guide you with a personal verse of promise for you in 2021.

Words to Live By Revisited

January's Memory Verse – *Let love be your highest goal.*
1 Corinthians 14:1

Monday 12/28- Read Philippians 3:8-14

Question: What one thing does Paul focus his thinking on by forgetting what is behind and pressing on forward?

Truth: *I press on to reach the end of the race and **receive the heavenly prize** for which God, through Christ Jesus, is calling us.*
Vs. 14

Meditate: Proverbs 29:18 (NLT)- *When people do not accept divine guidance, they run wild. But whoever obeys the law is joyful.*

Prayer: Lord, give me guidance and help me focus on Godly goals in 2020.

Action: Make a list of Godly goals for 2020, that with God's help I can accomplish.

God's list for my 2020 goals:

Tuesday 12/29- Read 1 Corinthians 9:22-27

Question: How does Paul focus his energy to meet his Godly goal "to save some"?

Truth: *When I am with those who are weak, I share their weakness, for I want to bring the weak to Christ. Yes, I try to find common ground with everyone, doing everything I can to save some.* Vs. 22

Meditate: 1 Corinthians 9:23- *I do everything to spread the Good News and share in its blessings.*

Prayer: Lord, you are always with me. May others see your Lordship working in my life.

Action: *So I run with purpose in every step.* Vs. 26

People I will find common ground with in 2020:

Wednesday 12/30- Read Proverbs 11:27

Question: Why is it beneficial to create good godly goals?

Truth: *If you search for good, you will find favor; but if you search for evil, it will find you!*

Meditate: Proverbs 15:9 - *The Lord detests the way of the wicked, but he loves those who pursue godliness.*

Prayer: Father God, I desire to find your favor and your blessing in my life

Action: Pursue good goals and be blessed by God.

What God is telling me:

Thursday 12/31- Read Matthew 9:27-31

Question: Should my goals help stretch my faith?

Truth: YES! Godly Goals will stretch my faith. *"Because of your faith, it will happen."* Vs. 29

Meditate: Romans 1:17- *This Good News tells us how God makes us right in his sight. This is accomplished from start to finish by faith. As the Scriptures say, "It is through faith that a righteous person has life."*

Prayer: Lord God, my faith is in YOU each and every day of my life.

Action: Live by FAITH!

What God is telling me:

Friday 1/1- Read 1 Corinthians 14:1

Question: What should be my highest goal for 2021?

Truth: *Let love be your highest goal!*

Meditate: Ephesians 4:15 – *Instead, we will speak the truth in love, growing in every way more and more like Christ, who is the head of his body, the church.*

Prayer: Father God, help me to be more loving to others and share the Good News with them.

Action: Demonstrate my love for God by loving others.
