TALK IT OVER

Discuss these questions with someone – maybe a family member, friend, or member of your LifeGroup. Use a communication method that works best for your situation.

1. Relationships are a two-way street. God demonstrated His love for us by sacrificing Jesus, and by sending His Spirit to lead us into eternal life. What are some appropriate responses to God’s initiation of relationship? What are some ways you can demonstrate love for God?
2. Everyone spends their time, energy and effort in pursuit of something. We call this worship. The question is: Is what we worship worthy? Worship of God builds community and enriches others. Are there any areas of your life that do not demonstrate loving others or loving God (a life-style of worship)?
3. Do you keep a quiet time with God? If so, what does that time look like? How does it draw you closer to God, and what changes have come about in your life as a result?
4. Imagine you are a part of a hobbyist group. How does your connection to that group deepen your passion for the hobby? How can being part of a small group deepen your connection with God? What challenges and benefits from being a committed part of a small group do you think would be of greatest value to you? To others?
