1. **Read John 14:1-14.** How does Jesus lead us to God? If knowing Jesus enables us to know God, how can we come to know Jesus better?
2. What does it mean to ask or act “in Jesus’ name?” How do we know when we are asking or acting “in Jesus’ name?” How does asking/acting “in Jesus’ name” impact others?
3. The Old Testament taught to “love your neighbor as yourself.” Jesus gave a new commandment, “Love one another as I have loved you.” What is the difference between these commands? How should this change our perspective regarding how we relate to others?
4. Imagine you are training someone to perform a job that you are an expert at, what do you think is the most effective way to train this individual? What do you think is the most effective way to help someone learn to follow Jesus? How can you be that kind of encouragement and inspiration to those around you?
